

Running for Public Office

The Village Board consists of the Village President and three Village Trustees elected in odd-numbered years and three trustees elected in even-numbered years for terms of two years.

If you are interested in running for office, a handbook is available which will provide the necessary information and required forms including instructions. Candidates may begin circulating nomination papers on December 1 of each year.

The following forms must be completed and submitted to the Village Clerk's office located in the Municipal Building, 210 Cottonwood Ave., no later than 5:00 p.m. on the first Tuesday of January in order for the candidate's name to be placed on the ballot.

- Campaign Registration Statement (ETHCF-1)
- Nomination Papers (EL-169)
- Declaration of Candidacy (EL-162)
