Consideration of a motion to recess to closed session pursuant to State Statutes §19.85 (1)(a), deliberating concerning a case which was the subject of any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before that governmental body, (f), considering financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific persons which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations and (g), conferring with legal counsel for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved regarding deliberating and considering an appeal of the Sex Offender Residency Moratorium and to adjourn thereafter without reconvening in open session pursuant to §19.85(2).
