

**ICE AGE TRAIL COMMUNITY COMMITTEE AGENDA**

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Kelli Yogerst.

**Motion (Callies/Romagna) to nominate Muenzenberger as interim-chairperson for tonight's meeting. Carried (7-0).**

1. **Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of May 7, 2019.**  
Motion (Georgson / Van Thiel) to approve the minutes of the IATC meeting of May 7, 2019. Carried (7-0).

2. **Discussion and consideration of:**

- a. **Using funds to have Banner made for Hometown Celebration –**

Having a banner made for the Hometown Celebration parade was brought by Georgson. She said it would be nice to have something to hold in front of the truck plus so they can use it in the future. Several ideas were brought up of who to use. She said she could borrow one from the Alliance if they don't get one by the time of the parade, but she said it would be nice to have one of their own.

Motion (Muenzenberger/ Van Thiel) to use funds to have a banner made but not to exceed \$200. Carried (7-0).

- b. **Using funds for pins for completion of the Hartland segment –** Yogerst said in the packet is samples of 2 different type of pins. The price would \$3.85 for 100 with one time setup fee of \$25. It would be given to someone who completed the Hartland segment. Discussion on who would give out the pins also how to get the word out that the pin is available.

Motion (Yogerst/Callies) to approve and order the Hartland segment pin in the quantity of 100. Carried (7-0).

- c. **Tri-fold brochure to be used at outreach events outside the area –**

Georgson said Jessica Woodward from the Delafield trail committee would like to partner with the Hartland Ice to be used at events for example in Milwaukee & Mequon to explore our trails. She said the wording would need to be changed. She said Jessica is hoping to get some business sponsorships and she would like to have 500 printed. The idea of possibly using at local events was brought up and also using them down at Hotels for visitors.

Motion (Georgson/ Van Thiel) to approve the brochure but as long as there is no cost to the village.

**d. Final decision on rerouting the Ice Age Trail-**

Yogerst said last time Muenzenberger wanted to present it to the BID which he said he did this morning. He said there wasn't a lot of momentum to move it to the west side. Jess from Birch & Banyon said even though she likes the idea of going around her building she said the bank has been rather uncooperative with those kind of things in the community. She said they own where the grassy spot and trees by the drive through so they would have to go through cooperate, so the some of the thought was what's wrong with where it is at. (30:15) He said the alternative routes seem like there might be more resistance. The IATC recommendation is to keep it as it is, clean up the route and make it safer from cars. The BID seemed to like it as is also.

Motion (Muenzenberger/ Georgson) to recommend to keep the Ice Age Trail Hartland as it is, clean up the route and make it safer with the cars and 2<sup>nd</sup> alternative recommendation is between Zesti and the Emanuele building. Carried (7-0).

**3. Update on the Bark River clean-up project**

Muenzenberger said they had a nice crew, 4 people with chainsaws and 10-12 other people hauling, dragging trees and brush from the river between Hartbrook Park and the entrance to the private segment to the trail. He said a small group went back to the Centennial park area and finish taking down some of the area that was left over from last time. They also are going to have a small group finish the area they couldn't finish last night.

**4. Future meeting topics-**

Discussion on the Japanese Knotweed, who should address it and how to eradicate it. Yogerst said she will pass it on. Update on website and update on partner program on next agenda. Also decide on final dates for walk and Moonlight Hike.
