

**ICE AGE TRAIL COMMUNITY COMMITTEE MINUTES**  
**TUESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2019**

Present: Jim Muenzenberger, Dave Van De Ven, Jeff Romagna, Jeanie Georgson, Dave Thiel and Kelli Yogerst.

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Kelli Yogerst.

**1. Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of July 2, 2019.**

Motion (Muenzenberger/Georgson) to approve the minutes of the IATC meeting of July 2, 2019 with the correction of Van Thiel being excused instead of present.

Carried (6-0).

**2. Discussion and consideration of:**

**a. Moon light Hike on October 12, 2019.**

Yogerst will put in active net a link to where the Cottonwood Wayside is. Trailtessa event will be held at the Cottonwood Wayside that morning on October 12.

Muenzenberger said the BID could always be involved, he talked to the BID about donating things such as flashlights and luminary bags for example. He told the BID that they can reach out to him about helping out at the event. Also BID stated they can sponsor something for the hike.

Yogerst said that there needs to be one person responsible for the fire. She said they will need to fill out a fire permit and the Fire Dept. will stop by. Yogerst said they can use the chimney and fire pit and Thiel said if he is there he can take out the burn permit.

Yogerst said DPW will supply the wood and Georgson said she will bring granola bars that were left over from Hartland Kids Day. It was suggested to bring this back in September to finalize everything. Luminaries with battery operated candles would be nice and Yogerst said she will look into how much it would be to get a flashlight with a logo on it. Yogerst will give a price on the flashlights at the next meeting and will buy some luminary bags.

**b. Update on the Website–**

Yogerst will contact Lysianne about the changes to the website. Van De Ven asked about feedback and it was stated nothing has been heard. Suggestion was made to have a library program about getting to know your Ice Age Trail Community.

**c. Funds left over & decide what is still needed-**

Yogerst gave an overview of what money was spent and how it was spent. She said \$400 is left in the budget. Muenzenberger said it is nice to have a monthly update and would like it on the agenda on a regular basis.

**3. Update on the Bark River clean-up project-**

Muenzenberger commented on if they need funds for that for the Kiwanis. He said the cleanup date is Saturday August 24 and there will probably be 8-12 on the first round. He said it is a smaller event and not broadcasting it to the community. Muenzenberger said he took a walk with DPW and Administrator Bailey and they came to the decision to focus on areas that do not butt up to an owner's land. He said the Village will be responsible to make sure the path can be walked plus the Village will need to do some research on when a tree is on private land. On August 24 they will be working on what wasn't done in the spring then the southern border of Centennial can be done. He went on to say that in October they will be attacking where the mudder crews started months ago and the goal is to make the river passible. There was still some concern about doing work along the property side. Muenzenberger said they may need to get individual permission. Thiel suggested that everyone start at the same time. In October the date will be the 19<sup>th</sup> and will be a bigger event and Muenzenberger will appoint crew chiefs. Thiel listed what REI does on their work days.

**4. Future meeting topics-**

Monthly budget would like to be added to each agenda. Next month IATC will look at Website update, Moonlight hike on October 12, Bark River Clean update and the September 28 Hike.

**5. Announcements –**

Next meeting will be September 3<sup>rd</sup> and Park Board will be meeting that night at 7:00pm due to Labor Day. Romagna talked about the bridge at Palmers and the dumpsters at Palmers being enclosed. Georgson said Hartland Kids Day was a huge hit, lots of interest in Tyke hikes.

**6. Adjourn – Motion (Van De Ven/ Romagna) to adjourn. Carried (6-0).**
