

**ICE AGE TRAIL COMMUNITY COMMITTEE MINUTES**

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Kelli Yogerst.

- 1. Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of September 3, 2019.** Motion (Muenzenberger/Van De Ven) to approve the minutes of the IATC meeting of September 3, 2019. Carried (5-0).

- 2. Discussion and consideration of:**

- a. Moon light Hike on October 12, 2019.**

Yogerst will expand the registration for the IATCC members who already signed up. 2 people are needed to help with parking. It was stated people can park on the road and they will have flashlights and luminaries which office staff will help put together. Yogerst explained that they couldn't have a fire in the chimney due to chimney swifts being present in the chimney however they will have portable fire pits and she said DPW will have wood for the fire and she will put an email together regarding what people need to bring.

- b. September 28, 2019 Hike-**

There were 32 hikers including the volunteers and seven pins were sold. It was a lot of work and the Waukesha Chapter helped find an extra volunteer. It was suggested to not advertise 2 buses, because the 2<sup>nd</sup> bus wasn't needed. Callies said 2 time 1000 miler Todd McHanon was at the hike and offered to speak on the bus to the groups on the bus. Callies also has extra copies of the map.

- c. Kiosk at Centennial Park-**

Yogerst said the locks on the Kiosk are very hard to use, and the key that works for Nixon doesn't work at Centennial. There are several locks with different keys. DPW will look into putting on new locks and Yogerst will follow up on it.

- d. Donation of money for Fright Hike-**

Muenzenberger said he brought it up at the Kiwanis meeting and they gave \$150 towards the event. Brief discussion on a donating to the Fright Hike.

Motion (Muenzenberger/Callies) to approve a donation for the Fright Hike up to \$100 based on their need. Carried (5-0).

- e. Update on Website-**

Yogerst said some things were still missing. It was suggested to put on the events

page links from Lake Country Family Fun for events that are specifically 53029.

**f. Update on funds-**

Yogerst said the funds are now at \$313 with the donation of the \$100 to the Fright Hike.

**3. Update on the Bark River clean-up project-**

Muenzenberger said on August 24<sup>th</sup> there was a clean-up and accomplished what they were hoping to. He said the next clean-up will be October 19. It was suggested to try to get High School Students and others who attended the April event. The Village has approved we can use equipment and over time for staff. The Village is also willing to chip what is dragged out.
