

ICE AGE TRAIL COMMUNITY COMMITTEE MINUTES
TUESDAY, JULY 7, 2020
6:00 PM
ZOOM MEETING

Present: Jim Muenzenberger, Dave Van De Ven, Dave Van Thiel, Christina Callies, Jeff Romagna, Jeanie Georgson, Kelli Yogerst and Jessica Woodward – representative from Delafield Trail Committee.

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Kelli Yogerst.

1. **Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of February 4, 2020.** Motion (Muenzenberger/Van Thiel) to approve the minutes of the IATC meeting of February 4, 2020. Carried (6-0).

2. **Discussion and consideration of:**

- a. **Events to plan for 2020 update-**

Van De Ven said not a lot of events due to Covid-19, he asked if anyone had any events they wanted to mention coming up. Yogerst said she doesn't have any events coming up now but are looking at events in the fall like the October Hike with the chimney, the Moonlight Hike and the one from Delafield to Centennial. Brief discussion on how many walkers are participating in the walking club. Van De Ven asked everyone felt about holding events. Discussion included that people could be socially distanced, number of people could be limited to groups of 10 and doing virtual hikes. Discussion on putting together a virtual hike.

- b. **Financial status of budget amount-**

Not much spent on budget due to Covid-19. Yogerst said she will put in same budget amount as last year.

- c. **Promoting hiking events update-**

Discussion on a virtual hike and mammoth hike.

- d. **Status and plan for trail clearing in 2020 update-**

Muenzenberger gave brief update. Approx. 12 residents helped to clear between centennial park and T section that goes out to Rae Drive. Mainly clearing the trail of branches that were overhanging to allow equipment to get down the corridor. A few properties at the southern end of Centennial that have buckthorn that may be an October project. Last couple weeks it came to pd attention that where the split tree goes over trail, it has been there some time and DPW had to do something about it. Muenzenberger talked to neighboring properties and they are in favor of clearing it out. Muenzenberger gave tentative dates for trail clearing, August 14, Sept. 18 or 19 and October 17. Always looking for volunteers and will be looking at smaller groups.

e. Web promotion and status-

Muenzenberger said they were told that most of the work they put into won't be utilized. Yogerst said they told them will look at the webpage and make sure its updated. One suggestion was to have one person look at a certain page. Brief discussion on the nroote app and Strive on app. Yogerst will email the link to the IATC members and assign them a page to review.

3. Future meeting topics-

Continuing zoom meetings every month or every other month. Yogerst will come up with something for virtual hike. Callies will hold off on wee walkers hike. Yogerst said Hartland national night out was moved to October 6 at Nixon Park. Will meet briefly in August to get ready for potential things in October.

4. Announcements –

Callies said she still has opportunity to connect with high school students to Ice Age Trail or Park and Rec to work on projects.

5. Adjourn – Motion (Georgson/Romagna) to adjourn. Carried (7-0).
