

ICE AGE TRAIL COMMUNITY COMMITTEE MINUTES
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2020
6:00 PM
ZOOM MEETING

Present: Jim Muenzenberger, Dave Van De Ven, Jeff Romagna, Jean Georgson and Kelli Yogerst.

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Kelli Yogerst.

- 1. Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of August 4, 2020.** Motion (Muenzenberger/Georgson) to approve the minutes of the IATC meeting of August 4, 2020. Carried (5-0).

- 2. Discussion and consideration of:**
 - a. Events for 2020 update-**

Van De Van said the items he wanted to recover this time from the last meeting are the pins, the Mammoth hike and the Moonlight hike. Yogerst said they have about 75 pins and a few people have called and asked about them. Yogerst commented that she heard there were about 1000 people signed up for the mammoth hike plus the ad has not even gone out yet and Georgson confirmed it. Van De Ven asked how it was getting out about the pins and Yogerst said word of mouth and they must complete the whole segment. Georgson asked Yogerst to ask those people to post pictures on the Facebook page and Yogerst said she did ask them to send her pictures that could be posted on the Facebook page and would see how it goes. Van De Van said the second thing he wanted to talk about was the Virtual Moonlight challenge. He said they had talked about it but had not made any decision on it. Yogerst said they had just called it the Moonlight hike challenge on your own. Van De Van asked if it was in the program guide and Yogerst said no it was tied together with completing the trail for a pin.

Romanga said he is still doing his walks but the amount of people is down. Georgson brought up the 40 mile challenge and possibly to put up a tent at the last Beer Garden concert in the park on the 24th. There was brief discussion on possibly ideas of things to do in and around the trail such as a trivia questions or a scavenger hunt. Van De Van said they will do the trivia questions this time and the scavenger hunt the next time.

b. Status and plan for trail clearing in 2020 update-

Muenzenberger said they did some clearing August 14th and had about 13 helpers. It went from the T intersection off Rae Drive to the northern end of the boardwalk. He said approx. 7 properties on that section and received positive comments from residents. He said it was 2 ½ hours work and got way more done than he was expecting. He said they originally thought of doing 2 more events, a September one and an October one but got thinking they may only need 1, so they thought

September 25 and 26th would be good. He said even though Kiwanis likes the idea of involving kids he thinks it's a good idea not to given the current environment. He said doing it on a Friday works better for lower crowds. He said one more for sure but possibly could do an October one.

c. Web promotion and status-

Van De Van asked Yogerst if she got any feedback from what she sent out and she said she did not. Georgson commented on possibly putting some updates on businesses on the website. It was discussed to take this item off and possibly add something.

3. Future meeting topics-

It was discussed possibly going to every other month meetings. The zoom option seemed to work ok. Muezenberger brought up adding old business item to agenda for previous items to bring up. The vacancy of a board member is still open and should be put on the next agenda. Yogerst explained the process is someone is interested in the position. Georgson asked if the Village could post it on their website.

4. Announcements –

Muezenberger said he is now the ECOS committee and had some questions and didn't know if he could bring it up now. Van De Van said he didn't have a problem with it. His question was regarding another trail.

5. Adjourn – Motion (Muezenberger/Romagna) to adjourn. Carried (5-0).
