


Village Of Hartland

1900 hours

1. 1900 hours meeting called to order by Commission President Loppnow,
2. Commission Secretary Riesinger read the roll for attendance

3. In attendance: Police Chief Misko, Deputy Chief Collura, Captain Kelsey,

5. Presiding Commission President Loppnow requested a motion to recess into Closed Session pursuant to State Statutes §19.85 (1)(c), considering employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility, related to interviewing candidates for Police Officer.

8. Commission President Loppnow requested a motion to forward the Police Officer candidates: Kayla Nelson, Justin Hennlich and Kory Fons, to the Police Chief for further staffing consideration.
 - 8.1 Motion by Commissioner Riesinger / Patterson to forward the candidates to the Police Chief, carried.
9. Consideration of a Motion to Adjourn
 - 9.1 There being no further business to come before the Village Board of Police and Fire Commission, on motion to adjourn by Commissioner Loppnow / Patterson, carried unanimously .
