## RECYCLING/YARD WASTE SITE ACCEPTABLE/UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

<b>Aluminum and steel cans</b>	Containers must be cleaned out. NO paint or pesticide cans, aluminum foil contaminated with food waste, clothes hangers. NO PROPANE CANISTERS.
<b>Antifreeze</b>	Used antifreeze only. DO NOT bring a mix with other compounds.
<b>Appliances</b>	NO Freon-containing items.
<b>Building Materials</b>	NO asphalt waste, concrete blocks or bricks, insulation, lumber or roofing materials.
<b>Compressed Gas Cylinders</b>	NOT ACCEPTED
<b>Corrosives</b>	NO batteries.
<b>Electronic waste</b>	Not accepted. Please see Waukesha County's Electronics and Appliance Events at <a href="http://www.waukeshacounty.gov/recycling">www.waukeshacounty.gov/recycling</a>
<b>Explosives</b>	NO spent bullets, fire arms, ammunition or shells.
<b>Flammable materials</b>	NOT ACCEPTED.
<b>Glass bottles &amp; jars</b>	NO window glass, ceramic dishes, light bulbs, drinking glasses.
<b>Hazardous materials</b>	NOT ACCEPTED.
<b>Medical waste/biohazards</b>	NOT ACCEPTED.
<b>Newspaper, corrugated cardboard, magazines, office paper, unwanted mail</b>	Newspapers, corrugated cardboard, phone books, glossy magazines, catalogs, laundry detergent boxes, soda & beer cartons, cereal boxes, household mail, computer, copy and writing paper only. DO NOT bring food contaminated paper or boxes. NO carbon copy or blue prints, stickers and plastics, Styrofoam or packing material.
<b>Non-electronic</b>	NO tires, dirt, lumber, asbestos, office waste, fiberglass, solid waste, furniture, large plastic toys, VCR tapes.
<b>PCB'S</b>	NO capacitors, ballasts or transformers.
<b>Plastics</b>	Code 1, 2, 4, 5, and 7 soda, cooking oil, dish detergent, shampoo, mouthwash, milk, juice and fabric softener bottles, NO lids, other plastic items, motor oil, antifreeze bottles, pesticide bottles, foam containers, deli containers, yogurt or margarine tubs, plastic bags or Code 3, 6,. NO plastic bags or salt bags. Containers must be cleaned out.
<b>Radioactive Materials</b>	NO smoke detectors.
<b>Scrap metal</b>	NO glass, plastic, wood or any material other than metal.
<b>Yard waste</b>	Includes grass clippings, leaves, brush (6" diameter maximum, 6' length maximum), garden trimmings/plants only. DO NOT bring landscape timbers, lumber, rocks, sod, gravel, flower pots, stumps, root balls or other trash mixed in with yard waste. Bags must be taken home.
<b>Waste oil</b>	Used motor oil and oil filters only. DO NOT bring a mix with gasoline, antifreeze or other compounds. CONTAINERS MUST BE TAKEN BACK FOR REUSE.
