

Leave A Legacy

Bequests

A simple addition to your will can gift a portion or fixed amount of your estate to the Hartland Public Library. Charitable bequests can be made in the form of a specific gift of cash or property, or as a percentage of an estate, whichever is best for your circumstances. To find out about what advantages might apply to your specific situation, please speak to your attorney or financial advisor.

Create A Donor Fund Or Endowment

You may wish to create a donor fund or endowment for a specific purpose. Donor funds and endowments provide ongoing sources of revenue for library collections and programs and establishes a legacy for you or a loved one. A fund or endowment may be started with a minimum of \$1,000. Please contact the Library Director or Board of Trustees of the Hartland Public Library to discuss the creation of the fund.

Monetary Gifts

Cash or check donations can be made for general purposes, or donors can specify a preference for the use of their donation. If the donation is made for general purposes, library staff will then determine the most appropriate use of the gift.

All non-monetary donations will be considered by library staff. The library staff reserves the right to accept or reject any donation for any reason. Items accepted, including books and DVDs, may be sold at the Friends of the Library book sale.
